Elective Music and Music Scholarship Student Expectations

Students enrolled in elective Music classes or holding a Music Scholarship are expected to contribute to the College community through participation in Ensembles. To join, students should consult with their class teacher and parents/carers to determine the most suitable Ensemble for their involvement.

Rehearsal Expectations


If students cannot attend a rehearsal due to illness, they must notify the Ensemble Conductor and the Head of Performing Arts, Mr Jon Cavenagh, by email in advance of the rehearsal.

If students cannot attend a rehearsal due to other College events, they must email the Ensemble Conductor and the Head of Performing Arts, Mr Jon Cavenagh, in advance of the rehearsal.

If students cannot attend a rehearsal due to an other appointment, parents/carers are to email the Ensemble Conductor and the Head of Performing Arts, Mr Jon Cavenagh, in advance of the rehearsal. When making external appointments (medical, orthodontic and other), we ask that rehearsal times be avoided where possible.

If the student is participating in an Eisteddfod and they are absent without a valid reason on more than two occasions, they will be unable to represent the College in this Eisteddfod.

If a student fails to notify the Ensemble Conductor and the Head of Performing Arts, Mr Jon Cavenagh, by email regarding an absence from a rehearsal or performance on more than two occasions, they may be required to forfeit their place in the Ensemble. This decision will be at the discretion of the Head of Performing Arts.



Performance Expectations

It is the expected that students and parents/carers make arrangements to be available for all performances. This includes rearranging work rosters, sporting commitments etc.

For all major performances including showcases, festivals, workshops, music tours and Eisteddfods, parents/carers will be given three weeks' notice for performances and are requested to grant permission via the College App.

For internal performances occurring during school hours (applicable to Assemblies, Special Services, and other events) students will be notified via email and expected to meet all performance requirements.





Absences

Planned Absences

If due to exceptional circumstances a student cannot attend a performance, parents/carers must email the Ensemble Conductor and Head of Performing Arts, Mr Jon Cavenagh, at least two weeks prior to the performance. This allows the Department to come up with alternate Ensemble appointments.

In the case of performances that are scheduled in less than three weeks, parents/carers should email the Ensemble Conductor and Head of Performing Arts, Mr Jon Cavenagh, as soon as possible. Students who fail to provide notice of absence for rehearsals on more than two occasions or the appropriate notice of absence may forfeit their place in the Ensemble. For auditioned Ensembles, their position may be passed to someone else. This decision will be at the discretion of the Head of Performing Arts.

Unplanned / Unexplained Absences

If a student is unwell on the day of a performance parents/carers must email the Ensemble Conductor and Head of Performing Arts, Mr Jon Cavenagh, as soon as practical in order for conductors to find a suitable replacement.

College App & Parent Portal


A notification will be sent to parent/carers via the College App and/or email to grant permission for their child to attend an event.
