2016 Higher School Certificate Results

Dear Parents and Students,

On behalf of the Arndell Anglican College Community, we would like to congratulate our Year 12 students on achieving excellent results in the 2016 Higher School Certificate. This group of fine young men and women achieved the strongest academic results in the College's history with 49 band 6 results. For many of our students, they have indeed achieved personal best results due to the hard work which so many of them displayed over the two year programme of study.

The following subjects all had students achieve Band 6 results (the top band in the HSC):

Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Drama, English Advanced, Industrial Technology, Legal Studies, General Mathematics, Modern History, Music 1, PDHPE, Senior Science, Society and Culture, French Beginners, French Continuers, Hospitality and Studies of Religion.

Extension History, Extension 1 English and Extension 1 Mathematics also had one student each achieve E4 (the top band for Extension subjects).


84% of the HSC results were located in the top three bands for 2 unit subjects and 77% of Extension Subjects results were located in the top 2 bands.

Tomorrow, the ATAR results will be released and when we have an accurate indication from the students as to what they have achieved, we will inform the College community accordingly.


